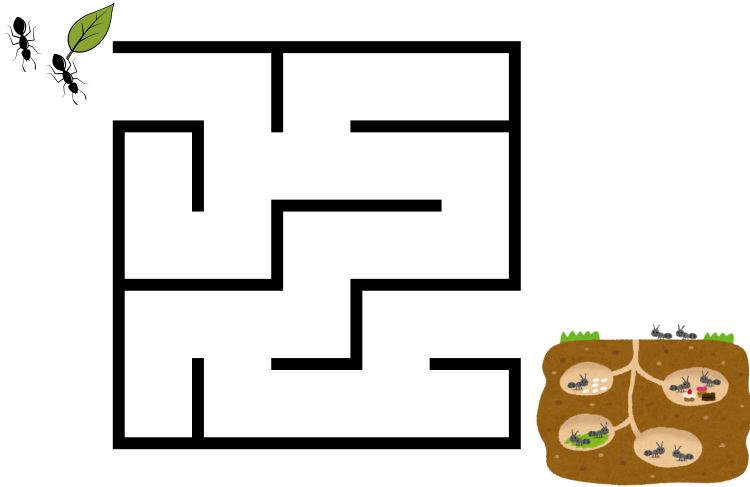


BUG Maze!

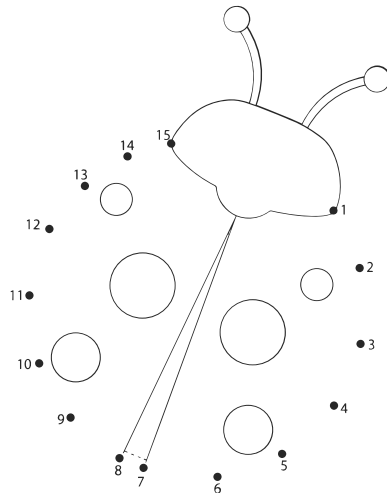
The ants found a leaf to bring back to their nest. Can you draw a line through the maze to help them find their way home?



Plant heroes!

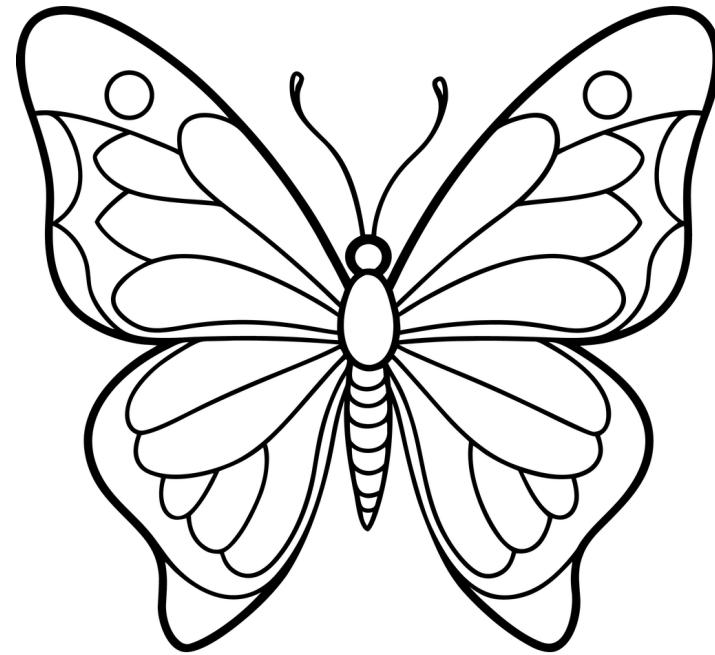
Work together to connect the dots, then color the creature!

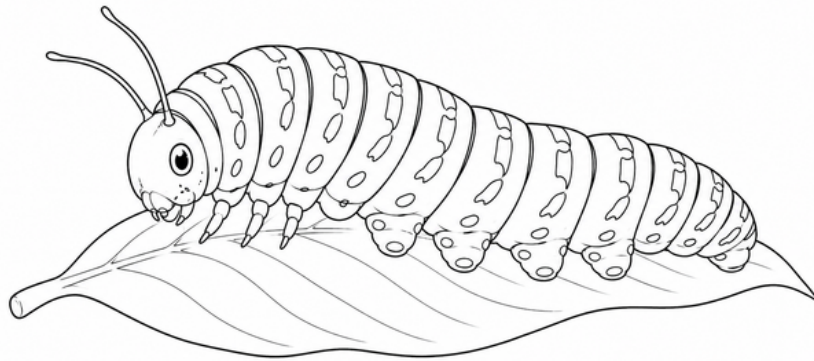

ANALYZE

7/20-7/26

ANALYZE means to look closely at something to get more information about it.



Can you **ANALYZE** this caterpillar and find the 3 **true legs** and the 5 **prolegs** that you can see on this side of the creature? Then color the picture!

Wait – what's a true leg and what's a proleg??

- Most caterpillars have 3 **true legs** on each side (6 total) - these are closer to their heads on their **thorax** (the section of their bodies that is below the head). A **true leg** is hard and has tiny claws at the bottom.
- They also have 5 pairs of squishy **prolegs** in the back that have small hooks on them (10 total). **Prolegs** help the caterpillar grip leaves and crawl, and disappear when the caterpillar becomes a moth or a butterfly!

EMERGE

EMERGE means to come out from a hidden place or come out so you can be seen.
